MICROBLADING

PRE CARE INSTRUCTIONS

It is imperative that clients must be OFF **RETIN A** and **RENOVA** or any such product thirty days prior to application and **ACCUTANE** for one year prior to application

THINGS TO AVOID 48 HOURS PRIOR TO Application, unless medically necessary

- 1. Asprin or similar products.** These thin your blood, so we do not want to risk unnecessary bleeding (Tylenol or Ibuprofen are ok)
- 2. Alcohol**
- 3. Niacin and Vitamin E**
- 4. Gingko Biloba, St. John's Wart or Evening Primrose Oil**

Continue anti-anxiety meds, if you are currently taking

Some clients may be more sensitive if they are premenstrual during a procedure.

If you have any condition that requires you to take antibiotics prior to going to the dentist, it is a good idea to check with your doctor to see if necessary prior to your Microblading Application.

Only use **NEW makeup** that may come in contact with the area after application. It is important to prevent secondary infection by being exposed to bacteria.

It is important **not to have sunburn** prior to and after any procedures. This includes tanning beds.

Do not book appointment before any major events like vacation, social events or weddings.
